



# SIGN UP TODAY FOR ALERTS & NOTIFICATIONS

Stay informed through the City of El Campo's alert messaging system, provided by Smart911. **It's FREE** (*message and data rates from your carrier may apply*). Receive voice, text, and/or e-mail alerts during an emergency situation. Along with emergency notifications, subscribers may also opt to receive other notifications for events such as road closures, utility work, service interruptions, garbage collection, etc. The alert messaging system is the quickest way to get information from the City when time matters. All personal information will be kept confidential.

There are 3 simple ways to sign up for alerts & notifications:

- Download the Smart911 application on your Apple or Android device, or
- Complete and detach the form below and return to City Hall via mail, drive-thru, Utilities Payment drop-box, or in-person at the Utilities Counter.

## June 1 – November 30

In addition to signing up for alerts & notifications from the City of El Campo, there are several measures that may be taken now to prepare for potential storms:

- Assemble an emergency kit that includes essential documents, supplies, and provisions.
- Review hurricane evacuation maps and select a route for you and your family.
- Consider special needs for individuals with disabilities or the elderly.
- Stay informed about changing weather conditions in and around your area.
- Follow the instructions of local officials if a storm develops.
- If you don't already have a battery-operated weather radio with several extra batteries, obtain one now. A NOAA Weather Radio with Specific Area Message Encoding (S.A.M.E.) is highly recommended.
